

MEMRAMCOOK POLICY ON SPORTS FAME RECOGNITION

P12-2022



1. Background

With the **Memramcook Policy on Sports Fame Recognition**, the municipality and its citizens hope to recognize the contributions and the achievements of all those who have worked in the field of sport in Memramcook over the years.

With the creation of a *Sports Wall of Fame* and the *Tribute Showcase*, it will be possible to pay tribute to our most illustrious athletes, builders and teams in an enduring way. We believe it is important for a community to recognize the successes and the achievements that have helped shape it.

In addition to being a form of recreation and physical activity, sport also helps to develop new skills, impart knowledge and increase social interactions. Sport is undeniably an important aspect of community life. The individuals and the teams to be honored will be recognized first and foremost for their achievements and their dedication to sport in Memramcook as well as for the source of community pride that they bring.

This policy will also help to clarify the selection process as well as the criteria by which an individual or a team will be recognized.

2. Memramcook Sports Fame Recognition Components

Sports fame recognition in Memramcook will include three components:

1. The *Memramcook Sports Wall of Fame* will consist of four panels which will recognize athletes, builders and teams in the following four levels of achievement: international, national, provincial and regional.
2. A *Tribute Showcase* series will recognize Memramcook athletes, builders, teams or sporting events in a more comprehensive manner by exhibiting sport related items, texts and photos.

3. The Sports Wall of Fame

1. Eligibility Criteria:

- a) Must demonstrate a certain level of accomplishment and good work ethics, in a sport recognized by the Memramcook Sports Wall of Fame Committee¹.
- b) Must be a Memramcook native or must have lived in Memramcook during a certain amount of time.
- c) Must be nominated in one of the following categories: athlete, builder² or team.

¹ Regarding the recognition of a sport, the Committee will refer to Sport NB's official list, while reserving the right to induct individuals or teams who have practiced other disciplines or activities.

- d) Must have reached one of the following levels of competition: regional, provincial or international.
- e) Must not have been active in the sport in question for at least two years (except for the “builder” category).

2. Candidate Selection:

- a) The Memramcook Sports Wall of Fame Committee will be responsible for selecting wall of fame candidate inductees each year; they will present their recommendations to the Municipal Council for their approval.
- b) The Committee will be made up of 8 individuals, including:
 - six Memramcook sports community representatives;³
 - a Municipal Council member (appointed by the mayor);
 - a municipal staff member (ex-officio).
- c) The Committee will meet as needed during the year in order to inform the Municipal Council of their time and location choices for the annual induction ceremony.
- d) Nominations for the Memramcook Sports Wall of Fame will be open to the public. Nominations will be accepted throughout the year by obtaining the consent of the proposed nominee and submitting a completed nomination form to the municipality. When nominating a deceased individual, we recommend obtaining the consent of the nominee’s immediate family.
- e) When a nominee is excluded from the current year’s list of nominees, the individual’s or the team’s name will be automatically added to a list of names that will be considered for the coming years.
- f) A minimum of one woman will be inducted each year, if possible, in order to ensure equal representation between men and women.
- g) A maximum of four nominees (individual or team) will be inducted into the wall of fame each year⁴.

3. Induction Protocol:

- a) An induction ceremony will be held annually.
- b) The accomplishments and contributions of the chosen athletes, builders and teams will be highlighted during a ceremony presentation.

² A “builder” is defined in this policy as a person who has contributed to the development of a sport for a considerable period of time, as a volunteer, an administrator, a coach, an official, etc.

³ Among the six community representatives, there will be two terms of three years, two terms of two years and two terms of one year, with terms renewable on December 1 of each year.

⁴ An individual inducted as a member of a team may also be inducted as an athlete or as a builder, provided that it is not for the same year of induction. Similarly, an individual can be inducted as a builder and vice versa.

- c) For each inductee, the following will be transcribed on the wall: the individual or the team's name, the year of induction, the induction category (athlete, builder or team) and the main sport for which the inductee is being recognized. In the case of a builder, the main sport will not be listed.
- d) For each inductee, a plaque will be given to the selected athlete, builder or team.

4. Tribute Showcase

1. Eligibility Criteria:

- a. Same criteria as for the Sports Wall of Fame, but may also include sports events that took place in Memramcook.

2. Candidate Selection:

- a. The Tribute Showcase Committee will be responsible for choosing the candidates as well as the sport related items and texts for the Tribute Showcase collection.
- b. The composition of the Tribute Showcase Committee will be the same as that of the Memramcook Wall of Fame Committee unless otherwise determined by the Municipal Council.
- c. The Committee will meet as needed during the year in order to inform the Municipal Council of their time and location choices for the annual induction ceremony.
